Welcome to Central Trains.

This guide contains times of Central Trains services for the period from 12th December 2004 until 11th June 2005.

In co-operation with train operators across the EU, we are bringing our timetable change into alignment with the rest of Europe, which will mean one major timetable change a year in December plus the opportunity for minor scheduling changes in June for the summer period.

You will find few major changes in this timetable except for:

- The number of services between Birmingham and Hereford has been increased.
- The 20.59 Birmingham to Worcester/Hereford service on Mondays-Fridays will now run through to Hereford, instead of requiring a change at Worcester.
- The 21.36 Hereford to Birmingham service on Mondays-Fridays will now run to Worcester with a connection onward to Birmingham.

Network Rail's continuing programme of maintenance and network investment means there may be engineering schemes that may disrupt your journey particularly at the weekend. Engineering Work

As part of Network Rail's continuing programme of maintenance and network investment, engineering work needs to be carried out. Airports

Please allow a minimum of one hour 45 minutes between train arrival and flight check-in.

Stansted Airport - allow 10 minutes to transfer to the terminal.

Nottingham East Midlands Airport

A direct, express bus service, called Skylink operates from Nottingham City Centre to Nottingham East Midlands Airport. It operates every 30 minutes in each direction between 0400 and 2300 hours and the journey takes about 45 minutes. You can board the bus in the City Centre at Carrington Street (for Nottingham Station) or Friar Lane (for Old Market Square). For further details telephone Nottingham City Transport Ltd. on 0115 950 60 70. The Skylink bus service is also listed on all Station departure screens, to further assist passengers who wish to get from Nottingham Station to Nottingham East Midlands Airport.

An hourly Air-Line Shuttle bus service operates from Loughborough and Long Eaton stations.

The terminal is a 5 minute walk from the bus stop.

Birmingham International Airport- is served by Skyrail offering a 2 minute connection to the terminal building. Birmingham International station is just 10-15 minutes by train from Birmingham New Street station with departures every few minutes for most of the day.



Reservations

Seats on all services in this guide indicated by \diamondsuit are reservable in advance. Seat reservations are free of charge and are generally available 8-10 weeks in advance of travel up to 1800 the day before departure. If you are booking online or by telephone you need to allow 5 days before travel for your tickets to be posted to you.

A new reservations system is being introduced over the Christmas period. For technical reasons, the reservations system will be closed for a short period while information is moved across from the old system to the new.

You can make reservations as usual up to 23.00 on 23/12/04 when the system will close, and from 12.00 on 27/12/04 when the new system will open. Train services are not affected and reservations made before this period for all December and New Year services will be handled normally.

Services from 24/01/05 will not become available for booking until early January.



Catering

Trains in this guide indicated by the \$\pi\$ symbol provide an at-seat trolley catering service for most of the journey. Trolleys on Central Trains services are provided by Xpress Catering Ltd. and offer hot and cold drinks, snacks and sandwiches.



Safety

In the interests of passenger safety, all trains are now fitted with safety instruction notices. Please take a moment when boarding your train to read the notice and familiarise yourself with the equipment provided for your protection.

Railway security is important:

- · Keep your bags with you at all times.
- · Report anything suspicious to staff.
- Help us to defeat terrorism report suspicious activity to the British Transport Police on 0800 40 50 40.



Assisted Travel

If you require assistance in making your journey please call 0870 609 60 60. We can make arrangements at many stations, please try to give a minimum of 48 hours notice wherever possible and have the details of your intended journey before you call as this will help us deal with your call efficiently.

A new booking system is being introduced over the Christmas period. For technical reasons, the booking system will be closed for a short period while information is moved across from the old system to the new.

You can make bookings for assistance as usual up to 23.00 on 23/12/04 when the system will close, and from 12.00 on 27/12/04 when the new system will open. Train services are not affected and requests for assistance made before this period for all December and New Year services will be handled normally.



Smoking

For the safety and comfort of all passengers, smoking is not permitted on any Central Trains service.



Cycles

A maximum of two cycles can be carried on any train operated by Central Trains in this timetable. On trains marked with \diamondsuit you need to reserve a space in advance. On other trains space is allocated on a first come, first served basis. Where a reservation is required this costs £1.00 for up to 2 cycles. Tandems and tricycles cannot be carried. 'Rann' trailers can be accommodated providing they are detached and treated as two separate cycles. Bagged and folding cycles are permitted as hand luggage subject to the normal luggage allowance. Cycles are only allowed in the special luggage area, please see the Senior Conductor before joining the train. Cycles are not permitted to be stored in any doorway.



Luggage Allowance

You may take up to 3 items of luggage free of charge i.e. 2 large items e.g. suitcase/rucksack to be stored safely and 1 item of hand luggage. Please ensure heavy items are stored in the luggage racks and not on the overhead racks as these are for light luggage only.



Police

The British Transport Police are the national police service for the railways. They can be contacted 24 hours daily on 0800 40 50 40.



Lost Property

If you have lost property on our stations or trains please contact our Customer Relations Team on 0121 634 2040 who will endeavour to locate it for you. If you find property, please hand it to the Senior Conductor on the train or to the ticket office.

Tickets

Please remember to allow sufficient time to buy your ticket at staffed stations before boarding the train. We offer a range of tickets to meet your travel needs. Broadly it is more expensive to travel at peak times during the week, and cheaper if you can travel at off-peak times, at weekends, or can book in advance (for longer journeys). The following types of tickets are available from your local staffed station, by telephone on 0870 609 6060 or online at www.centraltrains.co.uk.

Standard Tickets

These tickets are the most flexible and therefore most expensive. They can be bought on the day of travel and can be used on any train, at any time. Standard Single tickets and Standard Day Return or Standard Open Returns are available for most journeys.

Discounted Tickets

These tickets are cheaper as they can only be used after the morning peak (Mon-Fri) or anytime at the weekends. They can be bought on the day of travel. *Cheap Day Single/Return* tickets are available for many shorter journeys (under 50 miles). For longer journeys *Saver Single/Return* tickets are available.

Advance Purchase

On longer distance Central Trains routes, our Central Value range of discounted, advance purchase tickets may be available in limited numbers on most trains. The further you can book in advance, the cheaper the ticket (subject to availability). For details ask at your local staffed station or visit www.centraltrains.co.uk.

Season Tickets

Big savings are available for regular travellers with our range of season tickets. These tickets give unlimited number of journeys between any 2 stations in this guide for periods of 1 week, 1 month, or any longer period up to 12 months. Ask at your local staffed station for details.

Groups

Big discounts are available for small groups of 3 or 4, or for larger groups of 10+. Groupsave allows 3-4 adults to travel together for the price of 2, with up to 4 accompanying children travelling for just £1 each. Ask at your local staffed station for details. For groups of 10+ savings of up to 36% are available. Call us on 0870 609 60 60 for details.





We've invested in more trains so we can switch our 125mph Adelante fleet onto many services between London Paddington and Oxford and the Cotswolds, offering more comfortable journeys, with more seats and refreshments on board.

Buy before you travel

You should always buy your ticket before you start your journey, as long as there is a staffed ticket office or a self-service ticket machine. If these facilities are available and you travel without a ticket, you will not be able to buy reduced-rate tickets on the train or at your destination.

If your journey starts at a station where there is no ticket office or ticket machine, you must pay your fare to the conductor on the train. The conductor can issue the normal range of tickets.

In the interest of all customers, we aim to reduce the number of people who do not pay their fares on purpose and will check tickets on many trains and at stations from time to time. Please keep your tickets with you during your journey. You may be delayed leaving the station if you do not have a ticket.

Penalty fares

If you join one of our trains at Greenford or between Reading and Paddington, Bourne End and Maidenhead, or Slough and Windsor & Eton Central, and you do not have a valid ticket, you may have to pay a penalty fare of $\mathfrak{L}10$ or twice the single fare to the next station, whichever is greater.

Railcards

You may be entitled to buy a Railcard which can give you big savings on many fares, especially for leisure travel.

Examples include:

- · Senior Railcard (if you are 60 or over);
- Family Railcard (for adults travelling with children);

- Disabled Person's Railcard (for people with disabilities special conditions apply).

You must show your valid ticket and railcard when rail staff ask. If you do not, you will have to pay the full fare and will not be able to benefit from any discount.



If there is a fire or an immediate danger, you may need to pull an emergency alarm handle. This will apply the brakes but the driver can override this, if it is not safe to stop. The driver will contact you and ask you the reason for stopping the train.

In case of emergency

Look around. If there is no immediate danger, wait for instructions from staff on the train. If you are in immediate danger, follow these steps.

Stay on the train.

Move to another coach if necessary.



If you are the last, close the door behind you.



If the door will not open, find the door hammer and hit the cover with your fist.



Break glass in any corner of the door.

If you cannot stay on the train, once the train has completely stopped, leave through the exit doors.

Before leaving the train, look out for other moving trains and possible dangers.



Find the emergency door-release handle next to exit doors.



Pull the green handle down fully to unlock the door.



Slide the door open.



Sit on the step and jump to the ground.

If you cannot get off the train through the exit doors, leave the train through one of the breakable windows. There are two in each coach.



Find the window hammer and hit the cover with your fist.



Hit any corner of a breakable window. Do not hit the centre of the window.




Keep hitting the window until both layers of glass break.



Push out the glass using luggage or heavy equipment.

Before leaving the train, look out for other moving trains and possible dangers.



The diagram below shows a typical layout of a First Great Western High Speed Train coach. Layouts may vary, so it is important that you know where the emergency equipment is.
